

How much does a solar panel cost?

The average cost of solar in the U.S. is \$31,558,based on the latest cumulative data from the Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory,a Department of Energy Office of Science laboratory. Solar panel costs are calculated by the price per watt. The average price per watt in the U.S. is \$3.67 for an 8.6 kW system (rounded up).

How much does solar cost per watt?

Most of the time, you'll see solar system costs listed as the cost per watt of solar installed so you can easily compare prices between quotes for different system sizes. The average cost per watt of solar is \$3.00 per watt, but you may get some quotes that are slightly higher or slightly lower than average. Beware of extremely low solar prices.

How much does solar installation cost?

Installation labor accounts for around 5.5% of the total cost of a residential solar project, according to a 2022 report from the National Renewable Energy Laboratory. That amounts to \$1,375 for a \$25,000 solar project.

Typically, a 6-8 kW system--suitable for an average 2,000-square-foot home--will cost between \$15,000 and \$22,500 before applying any incentives.

Based on a 400-watt panel, the typical U.S. home needs between 15 and 30 solar panels to fully rely on solar power, which costs \$15,000 to \$42,000. That works out to a cost-per-watt range of \$2.50 to \$7 for a 6-kilowatt system or \$1.25 to \$3.50 for a 12-kilowatt system.
