They're an upgrade from your standard leveling blocks that you drive on to, as these leveling jacks for RV can be adjusted electronically, or by hand if you prefer.. Many RVs come with their own leveling system, but if yours doesn't have one, some leveling jacks will make life on the road much better, and you'll notice a huge difference to the comfort of your motorhome.
