How much does a solar panel cost?

Less efficient polycrystalline panels are typically cheaper at \$0.75 per watt, putting the price of a 400-watt panel at \$300. The cost of a solar panel also depends on how you buy it. If you purchase through a full-service installer, you will likely get a lower price for each panel than buying them individually from a retail store.

How much does a 5 kilowatt solar system cost?

The average 5-kilowatt (kW) solar panel system is \$14,210 before considering any financial incentives. However, a typical American household needs a system closer to 10 kW to adequately power their home, which costs \$28,241 in 2024. That price effectively drops to \$19,873 after considering the full federal solar tax credit.

How much energy does a solar system cost?

Before solar, this represents the average utility rate over the next 20 years, assuming annual rate hikes between 3-5% (based on location). After solar, this is essentially your lifetime energy cost divided by the total production of your system. Here's how that looks for the example system above: $\$45,102 / 242,483 \text{ kWh} = 18.6 \text{ kWh}$

How much does solar installation cost?

Installation labor accounts for around 5.5% of the total cost of a residential solar project, according to a 2022 report from the National Renewable Energy Laboratory. That amounts to \$1,375 for a \$25,000 solar project.

As of January 2022, the average cost of solar in the U.S. is \$2.77 per watt (\$11,080 for a 4 kW solar system). That means the total cost for a 4,000-watt solar system would be \$8,200 after the 26% federal tax credit discount (not factoring in any additional state rebates or incentives).

In terms of cost, polycrystalline panels are a much more affordable option, totaling approximately \$0.95/W. A 6kW solar system composed of these panels will cost at least \$2,000 less than a monocrystalline version. Finally, there are thin-film solar panels, which have the worst efficiency rating of the group at 12%.

So a 5kW system would cost around \$25,000-\$35,000 before rebates. While that cost is a stiff pill for many households to swallow, it's common for utility companies to offer incentives or subsidies to offset solar system costs.
