



# Cost of solar panels in missouri

How much do solar panels cost in Missouri? Solar panels will save you a lot of money over time, but the upfront costs aren't cheap. The average Missouri homeowner needs a 12.32 kW solar panel system to cover their electricity needs, which comes out ...

On the EnergySage Marketplace, solar shoppers in Missouri pay an average of \$32,000 for a 11.2 kW solar panel system prior to incentives. The savings from offsetting 100% of an electric bill with solar can add up fast!

Solar panels are worth it in Missouri. If you pay for your system with cash, you'll save about \$33,332 over 25 years (the warranty term of most solar panels) on electricity costs with a 5 kW system in Missouri based on real solar quote data from our Marketplace.

As of October 2024, the average solar panel system costs \$2.14/W including installation in Missouri City, TX. For a 5 kW installation, this comes out to about \$10,683 before incentives, though prices range from \$9,081 to \$12,285. After the federal tax ...

How much does solar cost in Missouri? Based on the latest data from the EnergySage Marketplace, the average Missouri homeowner needs a 12.32 kW solar panel system to cover their electric bills. That'll set you back about \$35,233 before incentives.

How much does solar cost in Missouri City, TX? Based on the latest data from the EnergySage Marketplace, the average Missouri City, TX homeowner needs a 13.47 kW solar panel system to cover their electric bills. That'll set you back about \$28,431 before incentives. Need a bigger (or smaller) system to offset your electricity use?

As of October 2024, the average solar panel system costs \$2.79/W including installation in Saint Louis, MO. For a 5 kW installation, this comes out to about \$13,932 before incentives, though prices range from \$11,842 to \$16,022. After the federal tax credit, the average price drops by 30%.

The average cost of a 10.8 kW solar panel installation on EnergySage is \$20,948 after federal tax credits. You'll probably save anywhere from \$28,000-\$120,000 over 25 years by going solar. Solar panels are just 12% of the total cost of a solar panel installation.

The cost of solar panels in Missouri (2024) Updated Oct 22, 2024. You'll pay an average of \$14,493 to install a 5 kilowatt solar panel system in Missouri, before incentives. The federal investment tax credit (ITC) lowers that price by 30% of all your solar equipment and installation costs.
