

Why does my alarm panel Beep a lot during a power outage?

On my system, the alarm starts a high-rate beeping every time the power comes back on after an outage (not when the power goes off). I put in the code to stop it, but it goes off about 2-5 minutes later.

Door Ajar Alarm. The beeping could indicate that the refrigerator door is not properly closed after the power outage. That triggered a door-ajar alarm. Control Board Reset. Sometimes, the control board needs to be reset after a power interruption. It helps to restore normal functioning.

All of our systems come equipped with a backup battery that can last up to 24 hours depending on the equipment that you have. In the event of a power outage, if you have one of our wireless systems that comes with the mysafetouch app and communicates via cellular signal, your system will still be monitored for as long as the battery lasts and there is still cellular signal.

All alarm systems get their primary power from a transformer that is plugged into an electrical outlet. A battery inside the control panel serves as a backup if you lose power. During a power failure, your alarm system can run on the battery for about 6-24 hours, depending on the power requirements of your alarm system.
