How much does it cost to install a solar panel?

Solar panels generate "free" electricity, but installing a system still costs money. A typical 8-kilowatt (kW) solar panel system costs \$22,712 before considering any financial incentives. Your energy needs determine the system size you need, which affects the overall price of your solar panel installation.

How much does home solar cost?

The average pre-incentive cost of home solar is \$29,161 for a three-bedroom house, or \$20,412 after claiming the 30% tax credit. However, as shown in the chart below, the number of bedrooms isn't a great indicator of the size and cost of a solar system - and neither is living space, for that matter.

Is one solar panel enough to power a house?

No, one solar panel is not enough to power a house. The average solar system has between 10 and 20 solar panels depending on the sun exposure, electricity consumption, and the power rating of each panel.
