CPS Energy (formerly "City Public Service Board of San Antonio") is the municipal electric utility serving the city of San Antonio, Texas. Acquired by the city in 1942, CPS Energy serves over 840,750 electricity customers and more than 352,585 natural gas customers in its 1,566-square-mile (4,060 km²) service area, which includes Bexar County and portions of its 7 surrounding ...

The 50 megawatts of additional community solar will allow San Antonio residents who live in rented homes, apartments, duplexes or other multifamily housing units -- or others for whom rooftop solar isn't feasible -- to have access to solar benefits, and will aim to support low- to moderate-income customers, said Ana Lozano, CPS Energy's director of Technology and ...

This version of the program seeks to reduce San Antonio's energy demand over the next half-decade by an additional 410 megawatts, enough electricity to power 102,500 homes on a hot summer's day, for roughly \$350 million, which equates to about \$3.50 on a customer's average monthly bill over five years.
